



# EMEurope R&I Projects Guidelines for Dissemination and Communication activities

The dissemination of activities and results achieved by the Research and Innovation projects selected under the EMEurope Call 2016 is of high importance for the EMEurope Initiative. For this reason, the R&I project consortia have the responsibility to communicate and disseminate their project results and continuously update the EMEurope Call Secretariat about their dissemination and publication activities via e-mail to [callsecretariat@electricmobilityeurope.eu](mailto:callsecretariat@electricmobilityeurope.eu).

Additionally the R&I project consortia are requested to support the dissemination and communication activities of the EMEurope initiative by sending information for the update of the EMEurope website and production of materials like brochures, e.g. R&I Projects Brochure published for the kick-off event in April 2018.

Please, be aware that a second brochure with the projects' results and achievements will be published after the end of the projects. The content for this brochure shall be supplied by the projects upon request by the EMEurope Call Secretariat.

All beneficiaries have the obligation to explicitly acknowledge that their action has received EMEurope funding. This must be done, if possible and unless the EMEurope Call Secretary requests otherwise, in all communication, dissemination and IPR activities resulting from the grant. The EMEurope/EC logos and reference to EMEurope funding must be displayed in a way that is easily visible for the public and with sufficient prominence, taking also into account the nature of the publication. For example, in slides for oral presentation the EMEurope and EC logos should be sufficient and no accompanying text is necessary. For other types of publication you shall include a text like the following:

*"This project has received funding from the ERA-NET COFUND Electric Mobility Europe (EMEurope)."*

The use of the EMEurope logo and European Commission logo is mandatory for all events, publications, websites etc.
